




### SPORT




# INTERIOR

he X-362 Classic and Sport appear in basically the same interior version, the only difference being an extra cabinet placed upon the main cabin's starboard shelve - outboard of the starboard longitudinal sofa in the Classic version (optional in the Sport version).

Khaya mahogany plywood and laminated Khaya surroundings characterise the elegant interior.

Leecloths can be fitted at both main cabin sofas - as well as the Sport version can have a freeboard hung pipe berth fitted in the port aft "locker".
