Beyond the main cabin is a large head that includes a shower stall, generous headroom, and good ventilation. Aft, is a huge private stateroom with standing headroom, plenty of stowage and private access to the head. 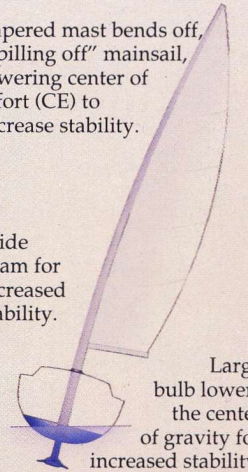

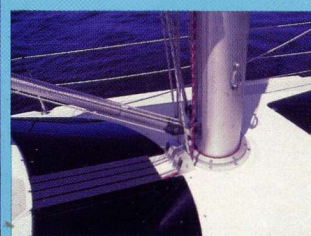
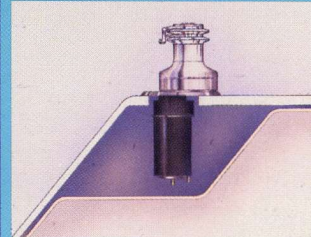
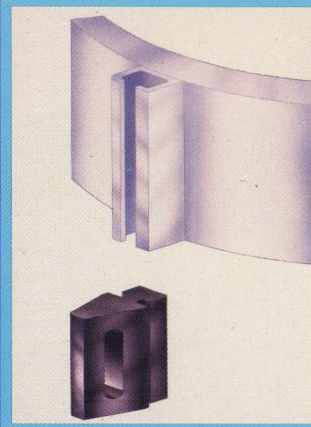
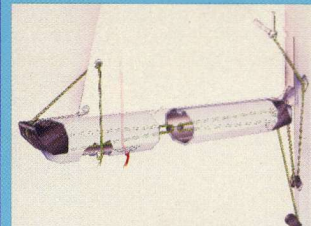


Tapered mast bends off, "spilling off" mainsail, lowering center of effort (CE) to increase stability.
